Supporting healthy and sustainable community:

- Create robust tenant protections and invest in public housing
- Expand housing stability efforts to fully connect renters and homeowners with resources to keep people housed and bills paid
- Fight for racial and environmental justice by addressing highway pollution, expanding green space and protecting tree canopy

Expanding city services and public goods:

- Use Green Line Extension refund to free the T and expand bus lines in Somerville
- Build critical infrastructure projects like municipal broadband and sidewalk shoveling
